BILL SCOTT – PRESIDENT, ABILITIES UNLIMITED, INC.

Bill is the founder and President of Abilities UNlimited, Inc., a disabilities issues consulting firm in Glendale, Arizona. He is chair of The “Disabilities Access Review & Advisory Committee” (DARAC) which was established by NFPA President and CEO, James M. Shannon in August 2004. Its purpose is to help the NFPA President to ensure that NFPA codes, standards, education, publications and related safety initiatives recognize and fully consider the needs of people with disabilities. The committee is comprised of 13 members, all of whom either have disabilities, or are family members of people with disabilities. Bill Scott is and has been the chairperson of DARAC since its inception.

As a member of the National Task Force on Life Safety and the Handicapped, Mr. Scott participated on a select panel to interview people with various disabilities who were involved with the evacuation from the World Trade Center in New York City following the February, 1993 explosion. The Task Force was then commissioned by the U.S. Fire Administration and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to develop an emergency evacuation guide, “**Emergency Procedures for Employees with Disabilities in Office Occupancies**”.
